

At Parklands Primary School we use Sports Premium to develop high quality curriculum PE and improve the sports provision and sporting opportunities for our pupils. We aim to have a sustainable impact on the healthy lifestyles of our pupils. We use our Sports Premium in the following areas:

- Quality PE lessons – training is provided by coaches alongside staff and staff attend training courses to enable high quality PE lessons to be led by teaching staff and therefore ensure this is sustainable after the Sports Premium funding ceases.
- Active playtimes - for pupils to have access to a range of activities at break times that keep them active and healthy in a safe play environment
- Intra school sport - for pupils to engage in a variety of inter school competitions and establish healthy competition between “Houses”
- Inter school sport - for as many pupils as possible to participate in a variety of competitive sport and sporting festivals with pupils from other schools
