Year 3 Celebration Day

We have all been delighted with how the children have enjoyed the first unit in our new Creative Curriculum, in which the work of Year 3 has been based on *James and Giant Peach* by Roald Dahl.

To make their learning even more exciting, on **Wednesday 10th October** we will be spending a whole day on activities related to the text, including art, drama, singing and food technology.

So the children can really immerse themselves in this fun day, we thought it would be great to dress up as characters from the book; particularly the mini beasts who become James' travelling companions (centipede, glow worm, green grass hopper, earthworm, silk worm). On the day, your child should come to school wearing black, brown, grey or green trousers, leggings or track suit bottoms, with a top in a similar colour – preferably plain and without patterns. Some children might choose to be ladybirds, in which case they should wear black or grey bottoms with a plain or spotted red top. We will make head dresses in school. **Please do not buy anything especially for the day.**

During the afternoon, we will look at some of Roald Dahl's revolting recipes, and children will make their own peach-based desserts, which they'll eat while they watch a film version of the book (U certificate).
