### English and Maths

Year 5 we are extremely lucky to have Mrs Armstrong, which means are maths groups are split 3 ways, this is a key strength as we have smaller maths groups we can tailor more to our individual groups. Each group will be doing similar things but will be based on the children in their group to really maximise their potential.

In English, just like year 4 they will be split into sets to make sure we challenge and nurture all of the children in our groups.

But also we have so many exciting topics in English this year that will cater to all of the children's interest to make sure we are engaging them in their learning.





### Reading

This year, we are still having a big push on reading, where we will focus on it in a lot of different ways.

One of the ways is our reading journals. Children can read 5 times with an adult at home and for it to be signed and brought in on Monday. If the children have read 5 times they will be put into a class prize draw every week with prizes to be one. We know life is busy and this wont be possible every week!

In addition, we have reading lessons every Monday as well as reading our class read every day from Monday – Thursday. In the children's reading journals you will see all the books we are reading this year if you wanted to know more.

Also on a Friday, we have reading for pleasure where the children can share their love of reading and this opportunity will be taken so the adults year 5 can listen to as many children read as possible and we will also put this in their reading journal so you can see that has happened.





# Spellings

Spellings are given out every Monday and are wrote in the children's journals.

Any help needed, just let us know!

Spellings can be a tricky one.





## Handwriting

Cursive is a handwriting style where all letters have an entry stroke which means letters always start from the same place.

Letters are produced in a flowing movement, which helps the development of a physical memory of how each letter is written.

Letters all start in the same place and flow from left to right, which reduces the likelihood of reversal mix-ups such as b/d and p/q.

Because of the smooth flow, writing soon becomes quicker and easier.

There is no messy transition stage when children move from print to a joined style. If cursive writing is taught from the start, only one style is needed.





### Curriculum

We truly have some amazing topics in year 5 and we do our best to fully immerse the children in to the topics. Some of these topics include Space and Earth and Australia!

With this we are currently looking into different workshops and school trips to really engage the children in their learning.

#### Our Curriculum focus this term:

This term Year 5 are flying into space to explore our solar system! They will be getting ready to blast off to explore each planet, identifying how life on earth is sustainable for humanity and why humans haven't been to mars yet. Discovering ways in which we could overcome this. So, watch out for a group of Year 5 astronauts on the news soon as we welcome the challenge of the journey to Mars. The children will use multimedia to design a presentation including a range of film, image, sound and text to present to an audience, using their astronaut minds, on why life on Mars could be sustainable. Could Mars be a new home for human kind? Year 5 will find out...







This year we are really lucky as the children will be getting two PE sessions a week, normally it will be one indoor and one outdoor PE session. Our PE days are Wednesday and Thursday.
