Dear Parents/Carers,

Coming home with your child tonight is an invitation to attend Level 1 + 2 in Bike Ability.



Bikeability is the only approved cycle training programme supported by The Department for Transport. It is designed to enthuse participants about cycling whilst equipping them with the skills and confidence to ride more often. All the training is delivered by qualified, professional, National Standard instructors.



Level 1 takes place in an off-road environment and teaches riders how to control and master their bikes



Level 2 gives participants on-road experience in residential traffic to help them prepare to make short journeys by bicycle

The course will run on July 6th – 9th, 2020, throughout the school day and is **free of charge**. To be eligible for the course, your child will need to bring to school their bike, and all other requirements that are stated on the form. Due to only 30 places being available for the whole year group, **it is a first come, first serve on who returns their completed forms by November 15th, 2019.**

Unfortunately, BikeAbility require us to provide them with the consent details by November 20th. We appreciate this date is considerably in the future, but if you could add the dates and information to your diaries, we can then submit the paperwork.
