This week's spelling rule: the sound /j/ spelt with g before e, i and y. The sound /j/ always spelt 'j' before a, o and u.

Can you put your spelling words into sentences? (gem, giant, magic, giraffe, energy, jacket, jar, jog, join, adjust) Challenge: Can you find any other words that follow this rule/pattern?

This week we have been learning how to use speech marks. Can you add the speech marks to the sentences below?

Top Tips:

-We use speech marks to show what somebody is saying.

e.g. "Why do you have to be so mean?" cried Cinderella.

-Always put any punctuation ?!, INSIDE the speech marks (shown in orange).

-Start a new line for a new piece of speech (when somebody else is talking)

Hello, said the man.

What are you doing? said Fred.

Stop! shouted the policeman.

Wait a minute, said Mark. Don't I know you from somewhere?

I know what we'll do, replied Lucy. We'll go to the pictures.

Challenge: Can you write your own sentences including speech? Try and include alternative words to said. Remember to start a new line for a new speaker.

e.g. "How are you today?" asked Lily.

"I am fine thank you Lily," replied Tim.
