### **Year 6 Residential Trip 2023**

In a positive response to the parent survey we sent our last summer, we would like to offer the children an exciting opportunity to go on a residential from Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023- Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023 at **Caythorpe Court (PGL) in Lincolnshire**. The total cost for the residential is **£400** and non-refundable which includes the activities (such as: abseiling, archery, raft building, high ropes course and climbing) breakfast/lunch/dinner, board and transport to/from school. We appreciate the cost is higher than previous years' cohorts, but having researched other competitors, PGL is the very best value.

To spread the cost of the trip into manageable payments, instalments can be made via ParentPay between now and May '23. If you have any concerns with regards to additional funding, please contact the school office.

PGL have advised that once the deposit deadline has passed, they will be unable to confirm additional places for children until much closer to the time; therefore, we recommend securing a place to avoid uncertainty.

After Easter, we look to hold a parent meeting to share further details of the residential, and to answer any questions. Understandably, we do require the majority of children to take up this trip offer for it to be able to run and for the price to remain as it is.
